The Company has selected projects which run for multiple years for implementation. The projects/programs sanctioned, including the carried forward sanctions of earlier years, but remaining unspent, are relating to such multi-year projects. The utilization rate of the CSR spending in 2019-20 was 96%. Our Company also contributed ₹ 2 crores towards PM CARES Fund to support action against COVID-19 pandemic. The Company could not sanction and spend the total amount for want of suitable projects. The Company is continuously evaluating the projects proposed to us and will be able to further enhance the spending in the coming years.
