Re: Issuance of Identity Cards to Pensioners/Family Pensioners of UIIC

Currently, HO Pension Department issues identity cards to all pensioners and family pensioners. The number of exits due to retirements / voluntary retirements / death has increased in the past few months. Further, due to final option for pension (OMOP), number of pensioners' / family pensioners has increased considerably. Issuance of identity cards to these new pensioners is becoming extremely difficult due to the high volume. The department needs more attention to process the pension and family pension applications for timely settlement of terminal benefits. Hence there is a need to decentralize the issuance of identity cards at the respective Regional Offices. This shall also reduce expenditure incurred on postage and alleviate the inconvenience caused due to non-delivery of identity cards.

Considering the above factors, it has been decided to commence issuance of identity cards at the respective ROs/LCBs with effect from 1st October, 2020 (retirement of September 2020 onwards). In other words, hereinafter identity cards for all exits starting 1st October, 2020 will be issued by the respective Regional Offices/LCBs and for Head Office, the same shall be issued by HO Pension Department. ROs/LCBs are requested to issue identity cards only as per the template format provided by HO and no deviation from the standard format is permissible (Kindly refer **Annexure-1A for pensioners' identity card and Annexure-1B for family pensioners' identity card**). The colour and design of the format shall also be uniform. Pension department shall arrange to print all identity cards for which forms have already been received upto 30th September, 2020.

Regional offices are requested to ensure that the identity card forms are retained at the RO/LCB itself before despatching the pension/family pension application forms. The identity cards shall be printed serial number wise and each RO/LCB shall be assigned a different batch of serial numbers from which the numbers need to be allotted (kindly refer **Annexure-2**). The identity cards need to be issued in that series only. The authorized signatory for issuance of identity cards shall be not below the cadre of Scale-V preferably from HRM department at RO level.

All details other than annuity number can be obtained from the filled in identity card application form submitted by the pensioner upon due verification. Annuity number will be provided by HO Pension Department via mail to all RO Personnel Officers / Pension Nodal Officer on a regular basis upon receipt of the same from LIC. A monthly report on identity cards printed during the month has to be communicated to HO – Pension Department by the Personnel Officer / Nodal Officer at RO / LCB by way of email (email id: hopension@uiic.co.in and hopensiongroup@uiic.co.in).


Regional offices/LCBs are advised to take cognizance of the same and arrange to issue identity cards to all pensioners/family pensioners without any delay.


ANNEXURE - 1A
